

How to take your Database files from a Vista, 7, 8 and 8.1 or 10

- 1.) Create a new folder on your **desktop** if on the same computer or plug in a **flash drive**
 - 2.) Navigate to **Computer/My Computer**
 - 3.) Double Click on **Local Disk (C:) Drive**
 - a. Double Click on **Users**
 - b. Double Click on **Public**
 - c. Double Click on **Public Documents**
 - d. Double Click on the **Pyramid** folder
 - e. Double Click on the **TimeTrax** folder
 - 4.) Once you are in the TimeTrax folder you will need to **Copy** the 3 files listed below
 - a. pyramid.ini
 - b. pyramid.mdb
 - c. pyrarchive.mdb
- * If you are unable to see the file extensions you will need to navigate to the top tool bar and follow these steps for Windows Vista and 7:
- Click on **Organize**
 - Click on **Folder & Search Options**
 - Click on the **View** tab
 - Uncheck "**Hide Extensions for Known File Types**"
 - Click **Apply**
 - Click **Ok** and the file extensions will appear
- If you have Windows 8, 8.1 or 10
- Click on **View** on the top tool bar
 - Check **File Name Extensions**
- 5.) **Paste** the 3 files that you copied in **STEP 4** to the new folder you created on your desktop or flash drive
 - 6.) Navigate to your Control Panel
 - a. Double Click on **Programs or Programs and Features**
 - b. Uninstall a program
 - c. Highlight Time Trax and right click and uninstall
 - d. Highlight Time Trax Sync if applicable and right click and uninstall
 - 7.) Double Click on **Local Disk (C:) Drive**
 - a. Double Click on **Users**
 - b. Double Click on **Public**
 - c. Double Click on **Public Documents**
 - d. Right Click on **Pyramid Folder** and **DELETE**
